How to Log Into Your Online Account

1. Go to caregiverlearning.org.

Log in with your SEIU 775 Benefits Group PersonID and the temporary password you were sent by email.

Press or click Sign In. You will be asked to create a new password.


2. The first time you log in, you will need to agree to the My Benefits Terms of Agreement.

> Press or click the Checkbox and the I Agree button to continue.


3. From the My Benefits homepage, press or



3. Scroll down the page until you see the filter and search bar. If you would like to filter by language, press or click the filter icon

and select your preferred language. Courses are available in: English, Chinese (ZH), Korean (KO), Spanish (ES), Russian (RU) and Vietnamese (VI).

Note: If there are no results for your preferred language, contact the **Member Resource Center** (MRC) for help.

4. You will see a list of Learning Plans. Learning Plans contain all of the courses you need to take to complete your training.

Basic Training 9 has 2 different Learning Plans to select from based on your preferred focus area:

- General Topics. This Learning Plan is for any respite caregiver.
- Autism. This Learning Plan is best for respite caregivers who are caring for clients with Autism.






- 5. To learn more about the Learning Plan you clicked on:

 - Press or click Learning Plan Structure to view the courses that are included in the plan.


Press or click the **Enroll** button to select the Learning Plan and enroll in Basic Training 9.

Press or click the **My Courses** button to see all of the online courses you must take.

2. Scroll down to the sections below the buttons.

The first section that you will see to your left is **My Training Requirement**, which displays your current requirement and hours remaining.


 To the right of the My Training Requirement section, you will see My Class Schedule. Any scheduled in-person classes and webinars will appear here.


IMPORTANT: This section will remain empty. You will not be taking any in-person classes or webinars for Basic Training 9.





You can start your online courses as soon as you select and enroll in a Learning Plan. Before starting an online course, make sure that you are using a computer, tablet or smartphone with audio and that your sound is on.

- There are a few ways you can get to your online courses. From the Caregiver Learning Center homepage:
 - Press or click the My Courses button at the top of the screen.
 - Scroll down to My Courses, located in the lower right section of the page, and press or click on the course you would like to take.
 - Scroll down to the My Training Course section in the lower left section of the page and press or click your Learning Plan.




2. Click on the course that you would like to start.



- After selecting a course, you will be taken to the course main page. Here you can begin the course, see your course progress, review the course description and get additional resources.
 - The main window of the course page is the Media Player.
 - To the right of the Media Player, you will see the Course Progress Status.
 - Underneath the Media Player, you will see the Course Description and helpful Resources.
 These are not required for course completion but may be helpful for study or practice.

To begin the course, press or click **Start At The Beginning**.



4. Most online courses begin with a preassessment. This is a quick quiz to see what you might already know about the topic.

Click on **Begin the Test** to start the preassessment.




5. You must answer all of the questions within the time shown at the top left of the screen.


Remember, you are not expected to know the answers. Do your best.

The score here does not impact your overall course completion score.


Select your answer to the question and press or click **Next Page** to move through the test.

8. Press or click **Next** under the **Course Progress Status** on the right side of the screen to continue the course.



Press or click **Start Course** to begin.






Press or click **Continue** to begin the lessons in your course.

 Go to the right side of your screen to the Course Progress Status. Press or click Postassessment.




13. Click on **Begin the Test** to start the postassessment.




- 14. After you complete the postassessment, you can:








Change Your Password or Preferences


1. On the Caregiver Learning Center homepage, click on the **Change Password/Preferences** button at the top of the page.

- 5. Use the drop down list to select the preferred time zone or language and click the **Save Changes** button.






My Training Activity

On the **My Training Activity**, you can review your total hours of required training, hours you have completed, hours you are enrolled in and the hours you need to complete your training requirement.


 On the Caregiver Learning Center homepage you can view the My Training Requirement section on the left side of the page or click on the My Training Activity button at the top of the screen.

- External Training will have any conferences or external training activities you have received credit for.







View Your Profile Information

The My Information page lets you view your demographic profile information from your employer records.


1. On the Caregiver Learning Center homepage, click on the **My Information** button at the top of the page to review your profile information.
